2009 Hainle Grand Reserve Red



2009 was an extremely good year for red wine. Nice and hot yet still enough rain to ripen our red wine grapes naturally without having to irrigate the vines. Our 2009 harvest stayed in medium Toast French oak barrels for 72 months. With this wine we wanted to create a typical Bordeaux style consisting of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. In addition to these noble grapes we added our famous Pinot Noir, Gamay Noir, Pinot Meunier and Baco Noir in order to get a more fruity wine. With this 2009 Grand Reserve Blend we have created our own house blend which already won top 1% in the world a few weeks after it was bottled. The wine starts out with the typical characteristics of a full bodied Bordeaux style wine. Black current, Black Jerrys, Leather, and good spices are very dominant in this blend. On the finish you get a great long finish with the extra Blackberry and Bacon taste the Baco Noir is so well known for. overall this wine is a great wine to bring to a wine collector and will cellar well over 20 years. It is our employees favourite red and highly recommended.
