



Hainle Vineyards - 2014 Hainle Grand Reserve Red 12 bottles

Case of 12 wine club special only.



2014 was an extremely good year for red wine. Nice and hot yet still enough rain to ripen our red wine grapes naturally without having to irrigate the vines. Our 2014 harvest stayed in medium toast French oak barrels for 18 months. With this wine we wanted to create a more fruity medium bodied wine. It consists of 80% Zweigelt, 10% Pinot Noir, 5% Merlot and 5% of our experimental reds (6 more secretly added noble reds). With this 2014 Grand Reserve Blend we have created our own house blend which is a follow up of our most successful blend the 2009 Grand Reserve Red which won top 1% in the world a few weeks after it was bottled. The wine starts out with the typical characteristics of a full bodied Bordeaux style wine. Black current, Black Jerrys, Leather, figs and good spices are very dominant in this blend. The finish is long with the extra note of Blackberry and Chocolate taste the Zweigelt is so well known for. Overall this wine is a great wine to bring to a wine collector and will cellar well over 20 years. It is our employees favourite red and highly recommended.
